What is a CSA? The Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) format is fairly simple—the farm sells “shares” of locally grown produce every year in different sizes. The members (that’s potentially you) buy a share for a set price and, in return, the grower provides you with a box of fresh, seasonal fruits and vegetables every week for the length of the season.

Why Belong to a CSA?

- ◆ **Introduces** new and unique varieties of vegetables that may not be widely available, thus increasing healthy eating and cooking.
- ◆ **Provides** members an opportunity to take an active and ecologically friendly role in the production and distribution of high-quality organic produce.
