What is a CSA? The Community Supported

Agriculture (CSA) format is fairly simple—the farm sells "shares" of locally grown produce every year in different sizes. The members (that's potentially you) buy a share for a set price and, in return, the grower provides you with a box of fresh, seasonal fruits and vegetables every week for the length of the season.

Why Belong to a CSA?

<u>Introduces</u> new and unique varieties of vegetables that may not be widely available, thus increasing healthy eating and cooking.

Provides members an opportunity to take an active and ecologically friendly role in the production and distribution of high-quality organic produce.
