WISCONSIN STATE 4-H HORSE ASSOCIATION All-Around 4-H Award

CRITERIA:

- 1. Youth must be involved in at least two educational events.
- 2. Only individual events will be counted (No team events).
- 3. Only the highest award will be given in each of the educational areas. The top 5 highest awards will be given in the horse area. (Hunt/Dressage/Cross Country, Gymkhana and State Expo will be eligible for these points.)
- 4. Awards will be given based on the following point system:

Grand Champion	5 points
Reserve Champion	3 points
Top Ten	1 point

- 5. Grand and Reserve will be given in both Junior Gr 3-8 and Senior Gr 9-13 divisions.
- 6. In the case of a tie, the member with the highest educational points, then the one who has a horse at State Expo, then the top amount of Grands, then the top amount of Reserves.
- 7. This award will be handed out at November Leaders Conference. You will be notified ahead of time if you are the winner.
- 8. The next year, we would like the winners to give awards out for education!
- 9. You must pick up your form at your first available contest or show to count the points for that show/contest and all future show/contest. You <u>will not</u> be able to pick up a form at a later show and count prior show/contest points. For example, if you pick up a form at State Horse Expo, you will only be able to count points from the State Expo Show any points from Gymkhana, Hunt Dressage, and Horse Education would not be counted.

ENTRY FORMS AVAILABLE AT ALL STATE EVENTS. Check with show office or registration.

Youth will be responsible for completing and turning in their all-around entry form.
