- Adding Wellness to Your Routine (Katy Carter)- Practice some wellness tools and skills to be a well-rounded individual.
- Amazing Llamas (Christy Wehler & Kelsey Kreul) Come learn what it is like to raise llamas including benefits, traits, and care for them. Limit 30
- First Aid for YOUth (Susan Thering) Learn the basics of First Aid including bandaging, splinting, and AED use. Limit 15
- Horse Trivia (Natalie Kieffer) Learn about horses or put your knowledge to the test! Limit 20
- Learn to Crochet (Petra Metzger & Jeena Metzger) no experience required, beginners welcomed. Session 1 only, Limit 20
- Robotics (Mike Pullen)- Introduction to robotics using super-cheap open-source brains and household parts. Limit 15
