ALL Swine animals must have a PRRS test (whether you showed them before or not). This is due to the fact that once you bring your market pig home, you've established a NEW herd of origin and you MUST test for PRRS because the Columbia County Fair is a Non-Terminal Show. Be sure this is done before you arrive at the fairgrounds!
